



Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 Scooter Skills

Fair Oak Junior School is taking part in the Walk Wheel Cycle Trust Bike It! & My Journey Schools project, which is designed to help children walk, wheel, cycle and scoot to school more often. Active travel is a great way for children to be more active and learn important road awareness and other life skills at a young age.

We have arranged for some playground Scooter Skills sessions for Year 3 which will take place on **Monday 18th, Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th May**

The lessons will be for roughly 1 hour and will take place during the school day, scooters and helmets will be provided.

Due to a limited number of smaller helmets we request that children bring their own correctly fitting helmet if they have one available.

The children will learn how to balance on and control their scooter around corners and obstacles, how to safely come to a stop using the brakes, and how to keep everyone using the pavements safe, and finish with a round of Scooter Limbo!

Please make sure your child is dressed for the weather.
