The children performed brilliantly throughout and finished strongly by winning every relay they competed in, representing the school with enthusiasm and teamwork.

Both teams showed great determination across all events, with Fair Oak 1 achieving an excellent first-place finish overall and Fair Oak 2 finishing seventh. These results highlighted the strength and depth of athletics across the school.

Fair Oak also entered two teams into the South Eastleigh and Winchester hockey tournament on Tuesday 27th January. Playing with skill and confidence, the teams finished in second and third place overall in a highly competitive event.
