IMPORTANT UPDATE - LITTLE OAKS AFTER SCHOOL CLUB

We would like to inform you of some upcoming changes to Little Oaks after school club, **which will take effect from September**. Following the success of our breakfast club booking system, we are introducing a similar approach for after school provision to offer greater flexibility and convenience for our Fair Oak families.

For existing users, the main change is that all sessions will now need to be booked in advance via the Arbor app. As part of this new system, accounts must be in credit in order to secure bookings. If you currently pay using childcare vouchers, please be aware that these payments can take up to two weeks to appear on your Arbor account, so we kindly ask that you plan ahead to avoid any disruption to your bookings.
