Hot Weather Arrangements

School will remain open as usual this week; however, due to the high temperatures forecast, we are giving you the option to collect your child early at 1:00pm on Wednesday and Thursday. This is in line with the infant school.

Here are the arrangements for early collection on Wednesday and Thursday:

- Children should be collected at 1.00pm from the astro (Years 4 & 5) or the main front gate (Years 3 & 6) with the exception of Sharman and Koala classes which should be collected from the main front gate to ease congestion on the astro.
- You will not be able to collect them earlier than that because of lunchtime arrangements.
- Children will only be released into the care of an adult whose name is on the collection list and no child will be permitted to walk home alone.

Please bear with us as this process may take a little longer than usual because we will be crossing the names of children off the list.

If your child is not being collected at 1pm, they will remain in school until 3.30pm and will be released at the end of the day as per the normal hometime arrangements.
