Year 5: 1:30–3:30pm



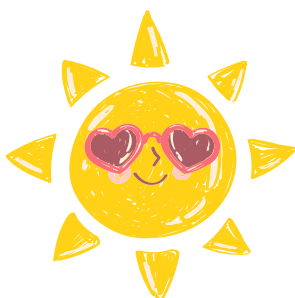
Children are welcome to wear their house colours if they wish, or they may wear their usual PE kit. Please ensure they have suitable clothing and footwear for the activities.
