Last year, 30 children (out of approximately 600 children at our school) started the challenge and only 17 finished it! Let's see if we can do better this year.

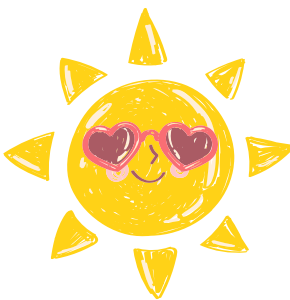


