Changes to Free School Meals eligibility

If your child currently receives Free School Meals, please be aware that the eligibility is changing at the end of this academic year.

From September, only families in receipt of Universal Credit will receive Free School Meals. All existing recipients will be reassessed in the coming months.

If you are in receipt of Universal Credit but haven't applied for Free School Meals previously because you had an income above the £7,400 threshold, you will now qualify. Please visit <https://apply.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/hants> to apply.
